RE: Town Hall Open for Business but Closed to Walk-In Traffic

On March 16, 2020, The Town of Bermuda Run joined with Davie County Government to proclaim a State of Emergency Declaration to coordinate the County's response to protective actions to address the Coronavirus Disease (COVID-19) emergency to provide for the health, safety, and welfare of residents and visitors located within the Town and Davie County.

On March 21, 2020, the first case of COVID-19 was confirmed in Davie County.

On March 21, 2020, the Proclamation of the State of Emergency Declaration for Davie County was modified to declare that a State of Emergency now exists in Davie County.

In keeping with Davie County Government buildings and offices protocol and to protect the health of Town of Bermuda Run office staff and residents, Bermuda Run Town Hall will be closed to walk-in traffic beginning Monday, March 23, 2020 and until further notice.

Bermuda Run Town Hall will operate for business via telephone and email Monday through Friday from 9:00am to 5:00pm.
