As we welcome September, we also welcome our formal celebration of the Town of Bermuda Run's 25th (Silver) Anniversary. In 1999, leaders in this community took the bold step to work with the NC Legislature to establish this Town many of us now call home. As you drive around our town you will see the new Silver Anniversary banners celebrating this important milestone.

This month, the town is hosting two concerts on the Town Green. The first concert is on Saturday, September 14th at 7pm with the Special Occasion Band; the second will be part of our Town's anniversary celebration later in the

month. Hopefully you can join us for some or all of these gatherings in this special month of celebration.

On September 27th and 28th—we will have multiple events celebrating our anniversary. On Friday, the 27th, we have invited former leaders of our town as well as current Town, County, and State representatives to join us for a luncheon to recognize and thank those who helped chart the course for where our Town is today.

That same Friday evening from 5-8 pm on the Town Green, we invite the entire community to join us for a family-friendly Food Truck Friday. There will be several food truck choices as well as live music from the band, Pushin' Georgia.
