Message from Mayor Mike Brannon

As we say hello to October and goodbye to September, let me again thank our team of volunteer planners and Town Staff for their hard work in organizing our 25th Anniversary celebration events last month.

Unfortunately, both our luncheon and Food Truck Friday events had to be cancelled due to the impacts of Hurricane Helene. The Food Truck Friday event is now rescheduled for **October 18**, so please plan to join us for that evening of food, games, music and prizes.

As many of you have noticed at the US 158 roundabout—in front of WinMock—our Flags at the Blue Heron Trail construction is underway! The engraved pavers that many of you ordered are also being etched and will be placed in the walking surface of that area as well. The current timeline has the completion of this project scheduled for late-November. Updates will be provided via Town meetings and social media. Once complete, this will be such a wonderful gateway to Bermuda Run and Davie County!

As discussed in our recent Town Council Meetings, road resurfacing work is scheduled for the month of October and will impact several roads throughout the Town. The Town's website has published a [document](#) that lists the roads and scheduled dates for this resurfacing work. Please be respectful of the work crews, follow their directions and keep their safety and the safety of other drivers and pedestrians in mind.

As a reminder, early voting will begin at Town Hall from Thursday, October 17 through Saturday, November 2. Voting hours are Monday-Friday from 8:00 am to 7:30 pm and on Saturdays from 8:00 am to 3:00 pm. Please take time to exercise your right to vote at this convenient location. ***Please note that this is only for early voting, and Election Day voting (November 5) will be at your assigned voting location.* Please visit the [Davie County Elections website](#) for more information.

Due to early voting in the main chamber of Town Hall, there is the possibility we will be moving the meeting location of our October Planning Board Meeting (October 16) and Council Agenda Meeting (October 22). If one or both of these meeting locations are changed, the Town will publish this information in the meeting announcement, the Town's website, and on social media.

On a sad note, we lost a person special to this Town with the passing of Kathryn Crosby. As many of you know, she was the driving force behind the Crosby Tournament held for many years at the Bermuda Run Country Club. Not only did this tournament bring celebrities from sports, music and television, it helped raise money for the Crosby Scholars program that exists today. If you are visiting Town Hall, I encourage you to take a few minutes to look at the many photographs of these celebrities who helped make this tournament—and Bermuda Run—so special. Rest in peace, Kathryn, and thank you for your passion for education and for embracing this wonderful Town.

I am also saddened to share the news of the passing of former Town Council member Jerry West, who served our community from 2011 to 2019. A long-time resident of Bermuda Run, Jerry was dedicated to improving our town and leaving a positive impact on those around him. His commitment to service, kindness, and leadership will be greatly missed. Our thoughts are with his family and friends during this difficult time. Let us honor his legacy by continuing to support our community as he did.

As I mentioned in last month's message, our five-person Town Council now has a vacant seat. While we will continue to move forward with our current council leading the Town, I want to again remind everyone that if you are a resident of our Town and have the time, energy and commitment to serve in this important role, I encourage you to reach out to me to discuss this opportunity.
